GRADES CRITERIA

Grades

Rustic / Rustic A / Premier

Rustic

Large and frequent knots including large, filled knots become a feature of the overall look. Rustic grade allows for a wide range of variation in colour and grain. The colour of the filler is intended to compliment the colour of the wood and may vary from batch to batch.

- Knots up to 80mm
- Filled knots, cracks, and other imperfections
- Centre core
- Natural colour variation
- Sapwood up to max. 25mm (on long side of boards)



Rustic A grade is a selection of premier grade and 'good' rustic grade material. It contains knots including filled knots up to 40mm in size. The colour of the filler is intended to compliment the colour of the wood.

- Knots up to 40mm, including filled knots
- Occasional, small cracks up to 20mm
- Natural colour variation
- Occasional sapwood up to max. 10mm



Premier grade has an even appearance with very few, small knots. The natural variation is limited, though can be more visible on fumed oak.

- Occasional knots up to 15mm
- Occasional, small cracks up to 20mm
- Natural colour variation
- No sapwood


Please note the selection process of prime/ premier grade boards wider than 245mm is usually more relaxed. The aim is to select calm boards with the minimum number of knots and grain variation.

COLOUR VARIATION

Fumed

The production process involves fuming with ammonia. This process results in colour variation between the boards / parquet pieces.

INSTALLATION METHODS

Fixed installation	Secretly nailed or fully bonded.	
Fully bonded over underfloor heating	Suitable for installation over underfloor heating. Floors must be fully bonded to the substrate. The temperature of the floor surface must not exceed 27 degrees.	
Floating on underlay	Possible, up to a board width of 245mm.
